- On Sunday, **November 30th** at 4:00PM we will hold a special Candlelight Communion service as a way of marking the beginning of the Advent season. This is one of the most meaningful and beautiful services held at Edgeboro.

- On Sunday, **December 7th** the Edgeboro Ensemble will practice from 12:15—1:15PM. Then on Sunday, **December 15th** the Ensemble will play before and during the two services. They will play a prelude starting at 8:45AM for the first service and they will also play starting at 11:00AM for the second service. They will also play some of the Liturgy music and some Hymns.
