I pray for health, blessing, love, growth, gentleness, forgiveness, joy and peace.

We Moravians proclaim ourselves Easter People: we live in hope. As you and I follow divergent paths, we know that ultimately all paths return us to our Beloved Creator, Savior, and Spirit. I carry you with me and no matter where I go—we are now connected in ways that have changed each of us. I am grateful for what you have given me and for the privilege of serving with you in ministry.
