Dear Edgeboro congregation,

We are very pleased to announce that we have finished the call process and found the next pastor of Edgeboro Moravian Church. Rev. Jodie Harney has accepted the call and will be installed as our pastor on Sunday, September 7th.

Rev. Jodie Harney, was born and raised in Bethlehem, 6 minutes away from Edgeboro. She graduated from Liberty (yes, Eric Smith was one of her teachers), Northampton Community College, Millersville University and Moravian Theological Seminary. She is a dedicated fan of the Philadelphia Phillies and Eagles and loves going to Friday night football games at Liberty. Pastor Jodie is married to Scott Harney, a transportation engineer and they have 2 children, Ben and Nate. Ben is entering 8th grade at Nitschmann and Nate is entering 4th grade at Asa Packer. Ben is very active in all things musical and dramatic and Nate takes swim lessons and has a very creative imagination.

Pastor Jodie grew up in the College Hill congregation. She was a Sunday School teacher, Youth Group Leader and a member of the Board of Elders. She has spent three summers on the Summer Long Staff at Camp Hope in addition to close to 20 years first as a counselor and then as Dean for Jr High Camp.

Pastor Jodie's Philosophy of Ministry is shaped by the beliefs of the Moravian Church as well as her lifelong journey as a child of God. She believes that our faith is strengthened by having an active role in the church family and joining together in fellowship and mission work with all of God's children. She strives to foster an atmosphere of acceptance and warmth, where everyone is encouraged to explore their faith, ask the hard questions, and grow in their relationship with God. It is vital to the growth of the church to engage in acts of compassion, justice, and mercy, both in our community and around the world.

For the entirety of her ministry, she has focused on Preaching, Prayer, and Presence. Pastor Jodie believes that as an Ordained Pastor, she is called to study God's word and share it as openly and honestly as she can even when it might not be what everyone wants to hear. Prayer: She believes that we can pray at any time, in any place and however we are most comfortable. Prayer allows us to communicate with our Triune God, to give thanks for all that we have received and to seek out God's strength, comfort, hope and peace. Presence: Pastor Jodie also feels the Holy Spirit's presence when she is sitting with a grieving family as a funeral is planned for their loved one, being present in a hospital room as difficult news is heard, or being in the company of anyone who just needs someone to listen. Through preaching, prayer, and presence, her ministry aims to reflect the transformative power of God's love through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit as we serve together as Christ's hands and feet.

Pastor Jodie shared the following - I am deeply grateful for the opportunity to walk alongside the members of Edgeboro Congregation in faith, ministry, and service to our Lord. I believe that God has brought us together for such a time as this, and I am eager to begin this new chapter - to preach the Word, to visit with the members of the congregation, and to share in fellowship with my siblings in Christ as we work together to build up the body of Christ. I hold you all in my prayers and I humbly request your prayers and patience as we begin this journey together.

The joint board looks forward to working with and supporting Jodie as she helps us grow as a church. We appreciate your prayers during this process and hope you will all join us in welcoming Jodie and her family as members of our church family!



Dear Friends

Thank you for your part in making 2024 a great year. The Freezer Ministry and Garden Gatherers School Farmers Market is serving 11 Bethlehem Community and Title 1 schools (for students of low income families) by distributing approximately 60 tons of fresh produce. Each family receives about 30 pounds of nutritious vegetables and fruit every month from March through November. The Frozen meals program continued its distributors of 20,000+ annually. Combined, both programs provided 116,000 meal or meal equivalents in 2024. The goal for 2025 is 200,000 meals to our communities in need.

This is only possible thanks to your generous support!

This year, our costs have increased by almost \$25,000. In order to continue to fulfill our mission, we have joined a new partnership with Blessings of Hope (BoH) in Lancaster, PA. Through BoH, we can purchase extremely good quality produce for a fraction of the cost, approximately 39 cents per pound, in order to feed hungry families in our local community. This makes our resources go much further in feeding our brothers and sisters in need.

Can you consider joining us in feeding the hungry by making a gift to support us in this work?

- A gift of \$250 provides 10 cases of broccoli
- A gift of \$100 provides 100 pounds of oranges
- A gift of \$50 provides 120 pounds of produce from BoH

We will soon be launching our website.

INDOOR DROP-OFF—Bring all items to the donation room (“Old office”).

OUTDOOR DROP-OFF—Place your items in the donation drop-off shed located at the corner of the building right off the parking lot.

- **ONGOING: Trex Plastic Recycling Program**—Edgeboro is collecting plastic! Since we began the program in February 2020, Edgeboro and the Bethlehem Moravian congregations have recycled **over six tons of plastic!**

Accepted plastics include: pallet wrap and stretch film, grocery bags, bread bags, case overwrap, dry cleaning bags, newspaper sleeves, ice bags, wood pellet bags, Ziploc bags, produce bags, bubble wrap and air pillows, salt bags, and cereal bags. (NOTE: All plastic must be clean, dry, and free of food residue.)



- The Elders last met on Thursday, June 12th. Their next meeting will be on Thursday, August 7th.

Flounder Parmesan

- 2 Tbsp butter
- 2 Tbsp. flour
- 1 c. milk
- 1 tsp. oregano
- 1 bay leaf

shared by Mrs. Palmer Eby

- 1 tsp. curry
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- grind of pepper
- 1/2 c. Parmesan cheese
- 4 flounder fillets

Bread crumbs

Melt butter in saucepan. Blend flour. Gradually add milk, using low heat. Continue stirring.

Add remaining ingredients (not fish). Slowly cook about 5 minutes or until thick.

Place fillets in buttered baking dish. Sprinkle lightly with bread crumbs.

Pour sauce over fish. Place under broiler until a few dark spots appear.

Thank you for your support of the work of the Board of World Mission (BWM). Your generous gift of \$300.00 (check #4055, dated June 13, 2025), for Nepal Mission Outreach helps us continue to make a difference in the lives of our Moravian siblings and their communities.

This is the 12th year that the Moravians are serving the Nepali community through education. In these 12 years, the school has grown from 49 students to 188 students, from 13 staff to 53 full-time and part-time staff. It has also expanded to two school sites, the Kindergarten and Shristi Academy (grade school). Likewise, it has established a good reputation, and we are now hopeful that enrolments will grow, as will academic and non-academic programs in the coming years.


Each financial gift to the Board of World Mission is an investment in healing the sick, feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, and welcoming the stranger. 
