As I type this article, worship for Ash Wednesday ended about 45 minutes ago. I find it interesting that between the people in the pews and the people online, we had about 40 people in worship. Interesting because the season of Lent starts today and Lent is 40 days (not including Sundays). I do not know why Sundays are excluded, but I am also not going to go and dive into a bunch of scholarly theological research to find out. We have a few short weeks before we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. So we have 6 weeks until Maundy Thursday to prepare our hearts and minds for the most wonderful gift that we as Christians have ever been blessed with receiving, the gift of eternal life. In the Gospel of John, we are able to read these familiar words:

“For God so loved the world that He gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. ‘Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.’”

God's love for us is so great that he was willing to sacrifice the life of his child with the hopes that we would turn our lives over to him. God had no guarantee that we would give our life over to him, how could he? God gave us the gift of freewill, the ability to make decisions for ourselves based on what it is that we want to do. God does not force us to follow his calling. God would not force us to claim Him as our Lord and Savior. God, being that God, does have the power to control us, to move us around as puppets in some great play, but God does not do that. God longs for us to come into mutual relationship on our own, of our own freewill, to accept God into our lives and to claim Jesus as our Lord and Savior. We do not have to be perfect to come to God, we need to be open to hearing what it is that God is trying to say to us.

During this Lenten Season, my prayer for our congregation is that we would all be willing to listen for God's still small voice over the clamoring distractions of this world. It is my prayer that we would all be truly open to the leading of the Holy Spirit, even if what we are being called to do isn't the easy option. So, I have to ask, what might God be saying to you? Are you willing to listen and to follow? How can your life be enhanced by having a deeper relationship with the Triune God? I pray that you would be able to answer these questions and to follow God's leading and I will be able to as well.

- Spaghetti sauce -thin


Homemade Manicotta:


