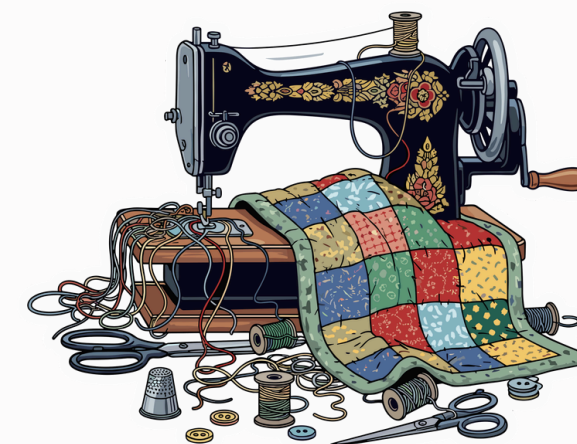
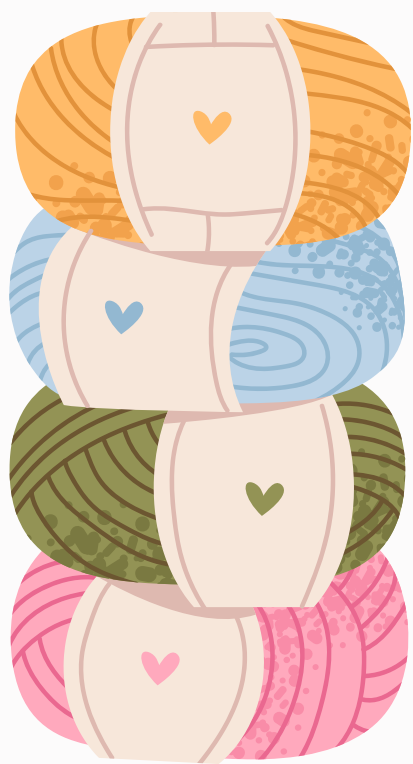
Blankets & Beanies for Teenies
