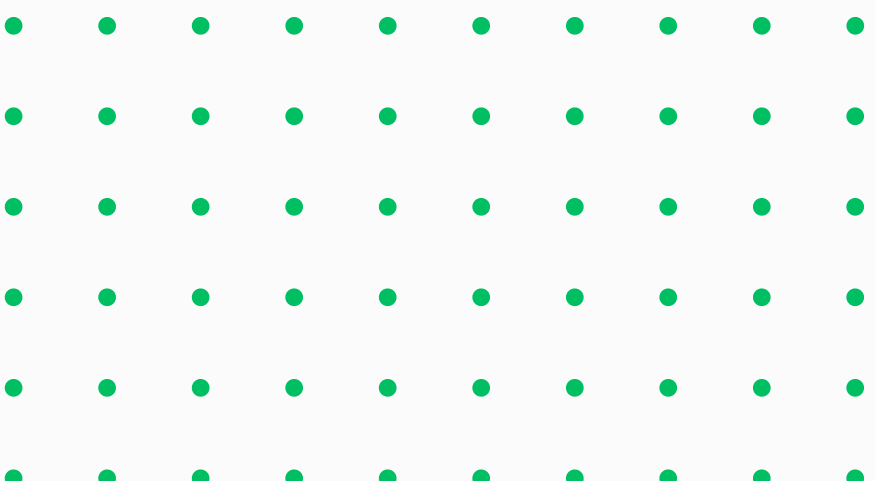

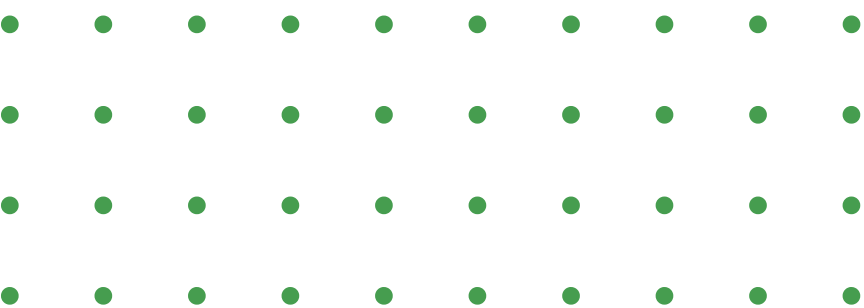
**PLEASE REMEMBER** if you have graciously sponsored flowers for Sunday to send a check into the church office with the word flowers in the memo line.

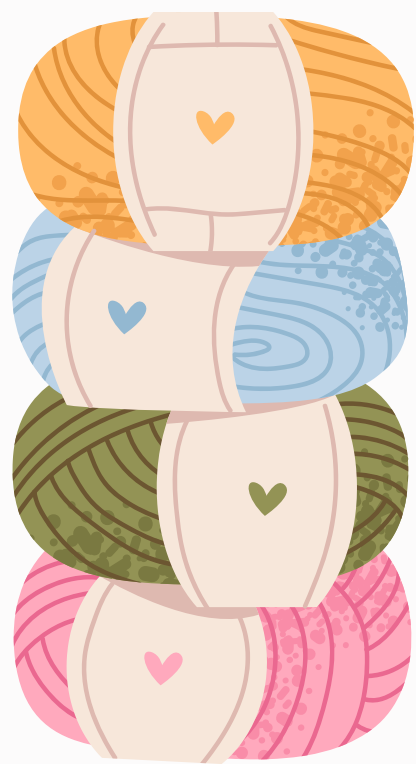


# Blankets & Beanies for Teenies

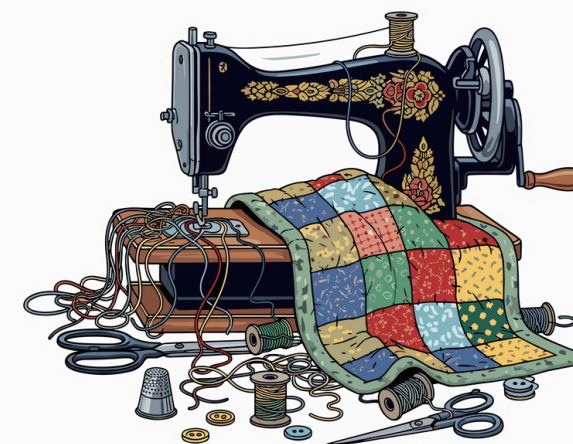


**Calling all knitters, crocheters, quilters, and sewers!**
