A decade after the American Revolution ended Johannes Ettwein, leader of the Moravian Church in North America, wrote about his meeting with Alexander Hamilton, then secretary of the treasury. 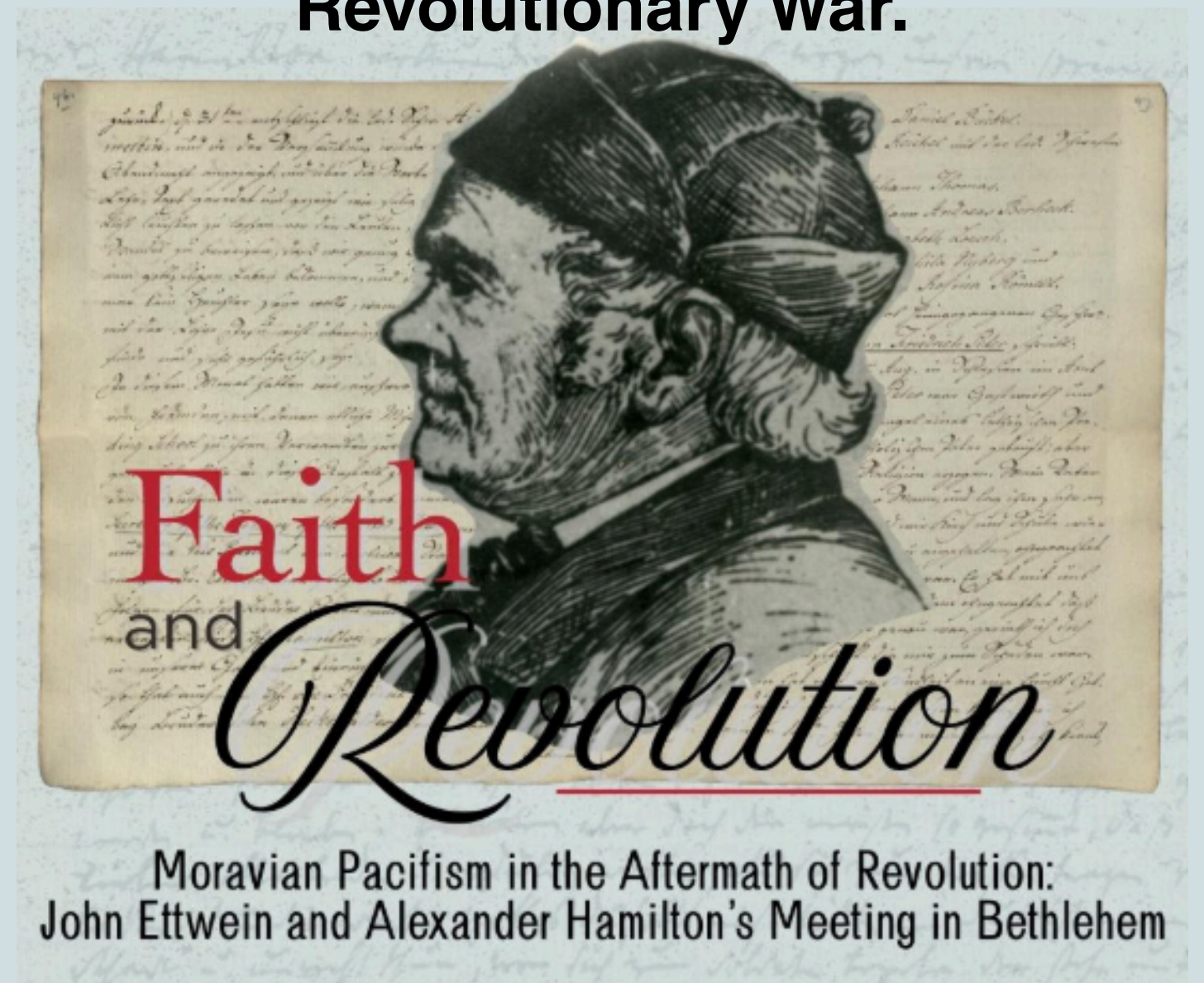

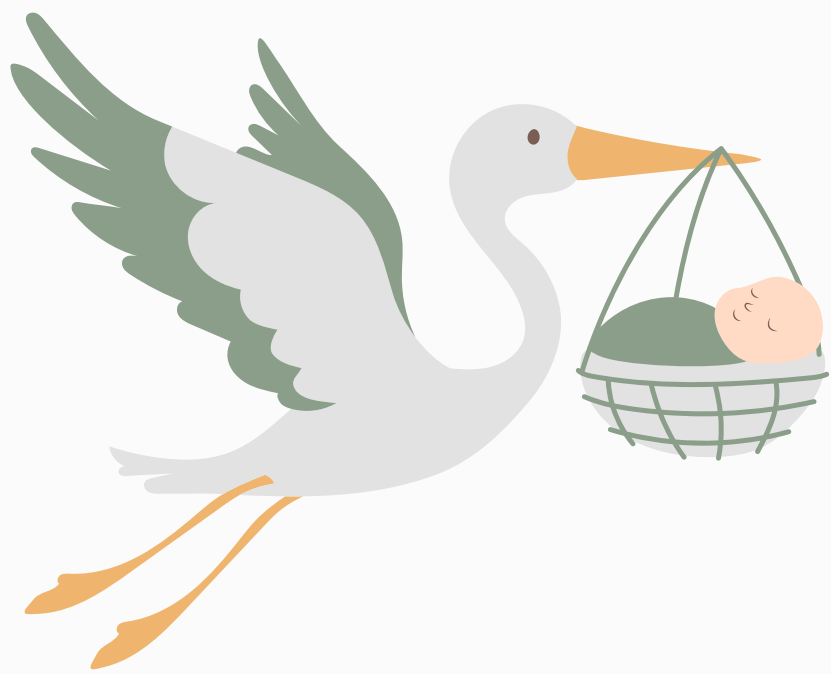

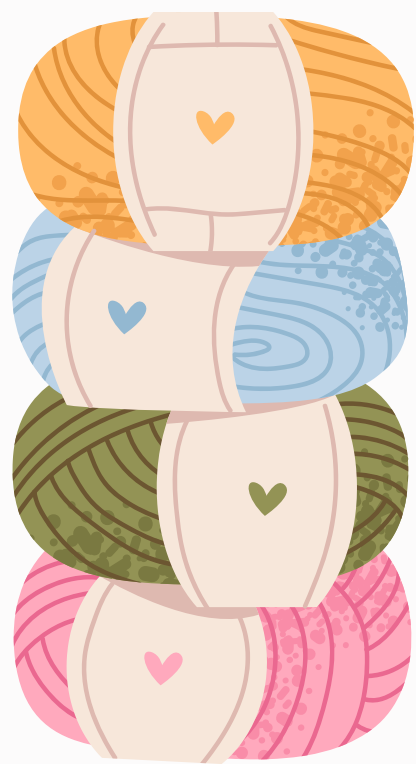


Blankets & Beanies for Teenies

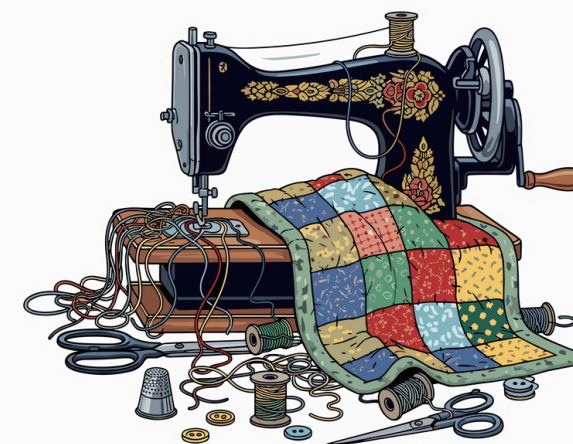


Calling all knitters, crocheters, quilters, and sewers!
